Director, Pulmocare Research and Education (PURE) Foundation, Pune President, Indian Chest Society Distinguished Professor of Research, Symbiosis International University Dr Sundeep Salvi is the Director of Pulmocare Research and Education (PURE) Foundation based in India. After completing his Specialisation in Respiratory Medicine, he obtained a PhD in clinical medicine from the University of Southampton in UK for his research on air pollution and lung health. He set up the Chest Research Foundation and recently the PURE Foundation where he is actively involved in conducting research, educational programs and advocacy related to asthma and COPD.

He has been a pioneer in the field of non-smoking COPD. He is a Member of the Board of Directors of GOLD and a Scientific Committee Member of GINA. He is ranked in the top 0.08% of the Respiratory Scientists in the world as per Stanford University's list.
